Hawai'i Medal of Honor in a ceremony at the HAWAI'I STATE CAPITOL



In a rare joint session of the Hawai'i State Senate and House of Representatives, the families of 28 fallen soldiers received the 2010 Hawai'i Medal of Honor in a ceremony at the State Capitol. The Hawai'i Medal of Honor, established by Act 21, Session Laws of Hawai'i 2005, "expresses the deep appreciation and gratitude of the people of Hawai'i to the loved ones of members of the military who sacrificed their lives in defense of our nation and its freedoms."

"Our condolences go out to the families of the dedicated soldiers who lost their lives protecting our constitution" said Senator English.
