BILLS INTRODUCED BY SENATOR ENGLISH THAT THE 2010 LEGISLATURE PASSED

- SB 1178 HD2**
Act 033, 4/19/2010
Appropriates State and federal funds to address Medicaid funding shortfall.
- SB 2105 CD1**
Act 141, 5/25/2010
Designates the disability and communication access board as the issuing agency for all windshield placards that are effective for six years.
- SB 2124 CD1**
Act 143, 5/25/2010
Appropriates Hawaii Hurricane Relief Funds to restore 2010-2011 instructional days.
- SB 2385 CD1**
Act 124, 5/19/2010
Extends University of Hawaii's (UH) fiscal authority and requires comptroller reports on moneys held outside the state treasury.
- SB 2386 CD1**
Establishes the UH capital improvements program project assessment special fund.
- SB 2389**
Act 042, 4/20/2010
Allows the UH to continue transferring funds, other than general funds and tuition and fees special funds, into their commercial enterprises revolving fund.
- SB 2449 CD1**
Act 85, 5/07/2010
Makes permanent the statutory requirements for provisional driver's licenses.
- SB 2461 CD1**
Raises rental motor vehicle customer facility charge from \$1/day to \$4.50/day. Appropriates funds for statewide rental car improvements.
- SB 2473 CD1**
Allows temporary residence to grandchildren of elderly residents of housing projects.
- SB 2563 CD1**
Authorizes the director of business, economic development, and tourism to administer the solar water heater system variances.
- SB 2770 HD2**
Act 051, 4/23/2010
Removes certain restrictions on drugs dispensed from remote dispensing pharmacies.
- SB 2811 CD1**
Act 125, 5/19/2010
Establishes a task force to study the feasibility of pharmacists immunizing children.
- SB 2812 SD1**
Act 007, 3/17/2010
Amends captive insurance company examinations frequency and requires accounts to be operated only under forms authorized by the Commissioner.
- SB 2834 SD1**
Act 023, 4/15/2010
Establishes a wagering loss deduction for state income taxes. Applies retroactively beginning after December 31, 2008.
