How to Check the Status of a Bill

- 1. If you would like to check the status of a particular bill, please visit the Capitol's website at: http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/
- 2. Enter your bill number in the "Bill Status/Measure Status" box, located on the upper left side.
- 3. Please see example of a status sheet from last year's legislative session. The status sheet provides a wealth of information about each bill.
- 4. By clicking on the bill number on the very top, you will be able to view the most current version of the bill.
- 5. Below the bill number will be a brief summary of the bill, followed by the progress of the bill.
- 6. On the right hand column, you will be able to view all versions of the bill, committee reports, testimonies submitted, as well as the hearing notices.
- 7. When a bill is scheduled for hearing, a "Submit Testimony" button will appear to the right of the bill number. By clicking on this button, you will be able to submit your testimony.
