Mr. Minei will provide EMSAC with the neighbor island 12 perspective on first responder needs to support the committee's continued assessment of the 13 state-wide EMS system.

Dr. Michael Hayashi (GM 710), is a current member of EMSAC. He is the state trauma medical director, and a board certified surgical intensivist practicing at The Queen's Medical Center. Dr. Hayashi has demonstrated continued leadership and trauma care expertise that has benefitted EMSAC.

Dr. Sean Scott Covant (GM 709), is the Medical Director for the City & County of
