RELATING TO THE STATE FUNDS

The Department of Budget and Finance (B&F) supports the intent of House Bill (H.B.) No. 1115.

H.B. No. 1115 proposes to deposit any moneys received through civil action that would otherwise be deposited into the State general fund, to instead be deposited into the Emergency and Budget Reserve Fund (EBRF).

As the department responsible for administering the EBRF and EBRF-Separate Account, B&F supports the general intent of this measure. Due to the ongoing economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Legislature transferred much of the balance of the EBRF to the general fund at the end of FY 20. As of June 30, 2020, the ending balance for the EBRF was \$58,880,670, which is down from the previous fiscal year's ending balance of \$378,237,160 on June 30, 2019. In light of last fiscal year's depletion of the EBRF, we support the intent of H.B. No. 1115 as it would contribute towards replenishment of the EBRF.
