1 **Department Testimony:** The Department of Health (DOH) supports this measure to assure 2 sufficient resources to sustain and enhance the State's vaccination goals. With regard to COVID-19 vaccines, critical factors continue to evolve and change over time, such as levels of 3 4 federal support, medical and public health guidance, mutations of the virus, vaccine supply, and 5 the beliefs and behaviors of community members. As a result, it is not possible at this time to provide an accurate estimate of how much more funds will be necessary to achieve the Recovery 6 and New Normal impact levels in the State's Reopening Strategy. 7 The department looks forward to this ongoing conversation with the Legislature and other key 8 9 stakeholders. If the scope of this measure covers routine childhood and adult vaccinations, for example for 10

11 influenza, additional information can be forwarded.
