The Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT) supports the intent and provides comments on SB 935, SD2, HD1, which establishes the Office of Aerospace Development in the Hawaii Technology Development Corporation (HTDC), repeals the Pacific International Space Center for Exploration Systems, and transfers the rights, powers, functions, and duties of the Pacific International Space Center for Exploration Systems to the Office of Aerospace Development.

Office of Aerospace Development (OAD)'s mission is to facilitate dialogue and coordination among the state's government, private and academic sectors, and between state-based organizations and overseas institutions, both public and private, to promote the development and diversification of Hawai'i's aerospace industry. As the focal point in state government and in aerospace endeavors, establishment of OAD in HTDC will need funds to continue its work.
