- SUBJECT: SCR 218 / SR 178 URGING THE GOVERNOR'S COORDINATOR ON HOMELESSNESS TO INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM A LGBTQ+ FOCUSED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE HAWAII INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS TO ADDRESS THE SPECIFIC NEEDS OF LGBTQ+ YOUTH ACROSS THE STATE

Hearing: Tuesday, March 23, 2021, 3:10 p.m. VIA VIDEO CONFERENCE Conference Room 225, State Capitol

**POSITION**: The Governor's Coordinator on Homelessness appreciates the intent of these resolutions, and respectfully offers comments.

**PURPOSE**: The purpose of these resolutions is to urge the Coordinator to include a representative from a LGBTQ+ focused nonprofit organization in the membership of the Hawaii Interagency Council on Homelessness (HICH) to address the needs of LGBTQ+ youth across the state.

The membership of the HICH is mandated by statute in section 346-382, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The HICH currently has 27 designated members, including representation from federal, state and local government, homeless service providers, the faith-based community, and the business sector. Legislation would be required to add a LGBTQ+ organization specifically as a designated member of the HICH.

The Coordinator notes that the current membership includes representatives from the Continuum of Care (CoC) for each county. The CoCs are coalitions of homeless service providers and other community stakeholders that coordinate housing and services funding for homeless individuals and families. The membership of the CoC chapters for each county includes a wide variety of organizations, which include LGBTQ+ focused nonprofit organizations and representation. In addition, the CoCs include youth serving organizations, such as RYSE and Hale Kipa, which are engaged in specific programs for LGBTQ+ homeless youth through initiatives such as the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP).

Recently, the Coordinator convened meetings with Department of Human Services Child Welfare Services (CWS) staff and youth organizations from the CoCs to discuss issues related to expanding access to emergency shelter for unaccompanied minors under the age of 18. The meeting resulted in proposed amendments agreed to by all parties for HB282, which is currently moving through the Legislature. The Coordinator will work with the CoCs and other HICH members to encourage them to bring issues relevant to the LGBTQ+ and homeless youth populations for discussion and action by the HICH.
