The Department of Defense (DOD) provides written comments for testimony of SRC73 / SR55.

This measure, if passed would, appropriate funds to support the ongoing operations of the Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge Program. The Youth Challenge Program requires \$1.7M in State matching funds for fiscal year 2021-2022 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to support ongoing operations. Furthermore, at no additional cost, the Youth Challenge Program requests 3 abolished positions and 32 defunded positions be reinstated to meet our authorized number of 100 program staffing positions required by the Master Cooprative Agreement.
