# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PANDEMIC RESPONSE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Act 9, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, is amended  
2 by amending section 30 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 30. Notwithstanding any other law to the  
4 contrary, there is appropriated out of the emergency and budget  
5 reserve fund established under section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised  
6 Statutes, from the amounts received by the State of Hawaii from  
7 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, Public  
8 Law 116-136, the sum of \$61,000,000 or so much thereof as may be  
9 necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 to be used for the purchase  
10 and distribution of personal protective equipment and industrial  
11 hygiene products to hospitals, childcare facilities, elderly  
12 care facilities, businesses, non-profits, [~~and~~] schools, and all  
13 state departments and attached agencies, pursuant to Public  
14 Law 116-136 and associated guidance issued by appropriate  
15 federal agencies; provided that:



1 (1) All procurements executed pursuant to this part shall  
2 be exempt from the requirements of chapters 103D  
3 and 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes;

4 (2) Beginning July 15, 2020, a monthly report that details  
5 all allocations and expenditures shall be submitted to  
6 the governor and the legislature; and

7 (3) On December 28, 2020, any unexpended funds shall be  
8 transferred to the unemployment compensation trust  
9 fund established under section 383-121, Hawaii Revised  
10 Statutes.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
12 defense for the purposes of this part."

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


