
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNITED STATES SENATOR DANIEL K. AKAKA DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:

4 "§8- United States Senator Daniel K. Akaka Day.
5 January 4 of each year shall be known and designated as "United
6 States Senator Daniel K. Akaka Day" in memory of Senator Akaka's
7 long life of public service to the State and country. This day
8 is not and shall not be construed to be a state holiday."

9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2065.
