BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 88F-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "employee" to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 ""Employee" means a part-time, temporary, seasonal or
- 5 casual employee, as defined by rules of the board of trustees,
- 6 who is not eligible to participate in the employees' retirement
- 7 system of the State under chapter 88[-], but shall include any
- 8 member of the Hawaii national guard for a period of active
- 9 service that begins when the member has been ordered into active
- 10 service by the governor pursuant to section 121-30 and ends when
- 11 the member is relieved from duty by order of the proper
- 12 authority pursuant to section 121-29."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
