A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§103D- Purchases of local produce; specifications.
- 5 (a) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, any contract
- 6 for the purchase of local produce having a value of more than
- 7 \$250 shall be for a term of at least five years.
- 8 (b) For the purposes of this section, "local produce"
- 9 means all fruits, vegetables, nuts, coffee, eggs, poultry and
- 10 poultry products, livestock and livestock products, milk and
- 11 milk products, aquacultural and maricultural products, and
- 12 horticultural products one hundred per cent grown, raised, and
- 13 harvested in Hawaii."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
