BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 467B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§467B- Online charitable fundraising; raffles. (a) A
- 5 charitable organization may conduct an online charitable
- 6 fundraising event, including an online raffle, to benefit the
- 7 charitable organization or a charitable purpose.
- **8** (b) The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
- 9 to implement this section."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 712-1220, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending the definition of "gambling" to read as
- 12 follows:
- ""Gambling". A person engages in gambling if [he] the
- 14 person stakes or risks something of value upon the outcome of a
- 15 contest of chance or a future contingent event not under [his]
- 16 the person's control or influence, upon an agreement or
- 17 understanding that [he] the person or someone else will receive

1	something of value in the event of a certain outcome. Gambling
2	does not include bona fide business transactions valid under the
3	law of contracts, including but not limited to contracts for the
4	purchase or sale at a future date of securities or commodities[$ au$
5	and]; agreements to compensate for loss caused by the happening
6	of chance, including but not limited to contracts of indemnity
7	or guaranty and life, health, or accident insurance[+]; or any
8	online charitable fundraising, including an online raffle,
