### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the date of the
- 2 primary election was recently advanced approximately one month
- 3 from September to August. However, the deadline to file
- 4 nomination papers to run for office was not similarly adjusted.
- 5 A deadline to file nomination papers that is closer to an
- 6 election limits the exposure of candidates to the public. By
- 7 restoring the deadline to file nomination papers to
- 8 approximately three months prior to the primary election, the
- 9 public will have additional time to learn about the candidates
- 10 running to represent them.
- 11 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to change the
- 12 deadline to file nomination papers from the first Tuesday in
- 13 June to the first Tuesday in May for certain elections.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 12-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 16 "(a) For members of Congress, state offices, county
- 17 offices, and the board of trustees for the office of Hawaiian

- affairs, nomination papers shall be filed with the chief 1
- election officer, or clerk in case of county offices, [not] no
- later than 4:30 p.m. on the first Tuesday in [June.] May. 3
- However, in the event of a special primary or special election,
- the filing deadline shall be determined in the proclamation that 5
- is issued calling for the election as provided for by state law 6
- 7 or county charter. A state candidate from the counties of
- 8 Hawaii, Maui, and Kauai may file the declaration of candidacy
- with the respective clerk. The clerk shall transmit to the 9
- office of the chief election officer the state candidate's 10
- declaration of candidacy without delay." 11
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
