A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 201B-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Members shall be appointed by the governor for terms
4 of four years; provided that membership on the board shall not
5 exceed eight consecutive years; provided further that each
6 member shall [~~hold office until the member's successor is~~
7 ~~appointed and qualified.~~] be subject to the holdover limitations
8 set forth in section 26-34(b)."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
