A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ABUSE OF FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to add coercive
- 2 control as part of the petty misdemeanor offense of abuse of a
- 3 family or household member to the pilot program to strengthen
- 4 state and county responses to domestic violence and increase
- 5 violator accountability established by Act 19, Regular Session
- 6 of 2020.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 709-906, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by amending subsection (6) to read as follows:
- 9 "(6) It shall be a petty misdemeanor for a person to
- 10 intentionally or knowingly strike, shove, kick, or otherwise
- 11 touch a family or household member in an offensive manner [or];
- 12 subject the family member or household member to offensive
- 13 physical contact; or exercise coercive control, as defined in
- 14 section 586-1, over a family or household member and the person
- 15 shall be sentenced as provided in sections 706-640 and 706-663.
- 16 Upon conviction and sentencing of the defendant, the court may
- 17 order that the defendant immediately be incarcerated to serve

- 1 the mandatory minimum sentence imposed; provided that the
- 2 defendant may be admitted to bail pending appeal pursuant to
- 3 chapter 804. The court may stay the imposition of the sentence
- 4 if special circumstances exist."
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 11 provided that section 2 shall be repealed on June 30, 2026;
- 12 provided further that section 709-906, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 13 shall be reenacted in the form in which it read on December 31,
