RELATING TO BROADBAND ACCESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii public housing authority shall
 conduct a study on the state of broadband access in all public
 housing projects in the State. The study shall include but not
 be limited to:

- 5 (1) Costs that would be incurred to provide universal
 6 broadband access in all public housing projects in the
 7 State; and
- 8 (2) Any obstacles to providing universal broadband access
 9 in all public housing projects in the State.

10 (b) The Hawaii public housing authority shall submit a
11 report of its findings and recommendations, including any
12 proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty
13 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2022.

14 (c) The Hawaii public housing authority may request the 15 assistance of the legislative reference bureau in conducting 16 certain research or drafting the report or recommended
