
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRINCE JONAH KUHIO KALANIANAOLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that Prince Jonah
2 Kuhio Kalanianaole led efforts to convince the United States
3 Congress to pass the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920,
4 under which the department of Hawaiian home lands was created.
5 The legislature finds that requiring certain public buildings on
6 Hawaiian home lands to display portraits of Prince Kuhio is an
7 appropriate way to honor the prince's legacy as the Hawaiian
8 Homes Commission Act's author.

9 The purpose of this Act is to require certain public
10 buildings near mass transit projects and on Hawaiian home lands
11 to display portraits of Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole.

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
13 by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated
14 and to read as follows:

15 "§27- Prince Kuhio; portraits; buildings. Any public
16 building or structure that is located:



1 (1) Within feet of a mass transit project that
2 receives moneys from a surcharge on state tax
3 established pursuant to section 46-16.8; and
4 (2) On Hawaiian home lands,
5 shall display a portrait of Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalaniana'ole."

6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
