# REPORT ON RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DENIAL OF CLAIMS FOR LEGISLATIVE RELIEF

Pursuant to section 37-77, Hawaii Revised Statutes

Calendar Year 2021

Submitted to the Thirty-First State Legislature Regular Session of 2022

#### **AUTHORITY AND BACKGROUND**

Section 37-77, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the Attorney General to report annually to the Legislature on the claims for which a recommendation for denial is made. This reporting requirement is contrasted with the Attorney General's obligation under the same statutory authority to submit a bill to the Legislature that contains all of the claims for which payment is recommended.

As required by section 37-77, Hawaii Revised Statutes, any data and documents supporting the claims submitted each year are maintained in the Civil Rights Litigation Division, Department of the Attorney General, and are available for inspection by the Legislature.
