## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE ON THE TURTLE BAY REIMBURSABLE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 173A-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	" [ <del> [</del> ] :	§173A-13[] Payment of debt service on the Turtle Bay
4	reimbursa	ble general obligation bonds. [Notwithstanding any
5	<del>laws to t</del>	he contrary:
6	<del>(1)</del>	Beginning July 1, 2015, a nonprofit land conservation
7		organization shall file an application annually with
8		the board requesting \$1,500,000 from the land
9		conservation fund for the reimbursement of debt
10		service on the Turtle Bay reimbursable general
11		obligation bonds until the bonds are fully amortized;
12	<del>(2)</del>	The board shall not require the nonprofit land
13		conservation organization that is the recipient of a
14		grant for the payment of debt service on the Turtle
15		Bay reimbursable general obligation bonds to provide
16		any additional matching funds; and

2	(3) (a) The board shall be responsible for the		
3	reimbursement of debt service on the Turtle Bay reimbursable		
4	general obligation bonds from the land conservation fund in the		
5	amount of \$1,500,000 per fiscal year until the bonds are fully		
6	amortized.		
7	(b) Moneys [awarded] expended for the payment of debt		
8	service on the Turtle Bay reimbursable general obligation bonds		
9	shall be deposited into the Turtle Bay conservation easement		
10	special fund."		
11	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
12	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
13	begun before its effective date.		
14	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
