A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 302A-1132, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	" (d)	As used in this section, "private school" means an
4	education	al institution that teaches students in any grade from
5	kindergar	ten through grade twelve and that is [licensed or
6	accredited] either:	
7	<u>(1)</u>	Licensed;
8	(2)	Licensed and accredited by the Hawaii Association of
9		Independent Schools, Hawaii Council of Private
10		Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges,
11		Western Catholic Educational Association, Association
12		of Christian Schools International, or a [similarly
13		recognized] similar entity recognized by the Hawaii
14		Council of Private Schools that meets or exceeds the
15		standards set by the aforementioned entities [-]; or
16	<u>(3)</u>	Accredited by the Hawaii Association of Independent
17		Schools, Hawaii Council of Private Schools, Western

1	Association of Schools and Colleges, Western Catholic
2	Educational Association, Association of Christian
3	Schools International, or a similar entity recognized
4	by the Hawaii Council of Private Schools that meets or
5	exceeds the standards set by the aforementioned
6	entities, and submits health and safety documentation
7	to the Hawaii Council of Private Schools or the Hawaii
8	Catholic Schools office on an annual basis."
9	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
