A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CENTER FOR NURSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 198, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2003 (Act 198), established the Hawaii state
- 3 center for nursing to collect and analyze data and prepare and
- 4 disseminate written reports and recommendations regarding the
- 5 current and future status and trends of the nursing workforce;
- 6 conduct research on best practices and quality outcomes; develop
- 7 a plan for implementing strategies to recruit and retain nurses;
- 8 and research, analyze, and report data related to the retention
- 9 of the nursing workforce. Act 198 also requires nurses to fund
- 10 the activities of the Hawaii state center for nursing through an
- 11 additional fee assessed upon the issuance and renewal of each
- 12 nurse license.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to increase the center for
- 14 nursing fee from \$40 to \$60 per licensing biennium.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 457-9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 17 "[4] (a) [4] Upon the issuance of a new license and at each
- 18 license renewal period, each nurse shall pay an additional fee 2022-3092 SB2274 CD1 SMA-1.doc

- 1 of [\$40,] \$60, which shall be deposited in a separate account in
- , 2 the compliance resolution fund established pursuant to section
 - 3 26-9(0)."
 - 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 - 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
 - 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
