## A BILL FOR AN ACT

---

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES  
REVOLVING FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, part II, subpart B, Hawaii  
2 Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be  
3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:  
4       "§302A- Department of education commercial enterprises  
5 revolving fund. There is established the department of  
6 education commercial enterprises revolving fund into which shall  
7 be deposited all revenues derived from commercial enterprise  
8 operation programs undertaken by the department. Revenues  
9 deposited into this fund may be expended by the department for  
10 all costs and expenses associated with the operation of the  
11 commercial enterprises, including hiring personnel; renovating  
12 commercial space; and purchasing merchandise, supplies, and  
13 equipment, without regard to chapters 76, 78, 89, 103, and 103D.  
14 Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the department may  
15 transfer all funds at its disposal, with the exception of  
16 general funds, into the revolving fund to finance the  
17 establishment of new commercial enterprises. The department may



1 adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 governing the expenditure of  
2 revenues deposited in the revolving fund."

3 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
