A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 342L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§342L- Large capacity underground storage tank systems;
5	prohibited. (a) Beginning July 1, 2022, the department shall
6	not issue a permit for a new large capacity underground storage
7	tank system mauka of the underground injection control line.
8	(b) Beginning July 1, 2022, no person shall operate a
9	large capacity underground storage tank system mauka of the
10	underground injection control line, and no permit for a large
11	capacity underground storage tank system mauka of the
12	underground injection control line shall be renewed; provided
13	that this subsection shall not apply to operations necessary to
14	address maintenance required to safely support defueling,
15	environmental requirements, any operations directly related to
16	defueling, or requirements under section 342L-9.
17	(c) As used in this section:

1	Tat	ge capacity underground storage tank system, means an	
2	underground storage tank system with any single tank with a		
3	capacity	greater than fifty thousand gallons or with a total	
4	tank capa	city greater than one hundred thousand gallons.	
5	<u>"Mau</u>	ka" means toward the mountains or the encircled	
6	protected aquifer.		
7	"Underground injection control line" means the underground		
8	injection	control line represented by a dashed line on the	
9	departmen	t of health underground injection control program maps,	
10	made effe	ctive July 6, 1984, pursuant to section 340E-2 and	
11	identifie	d as follows:	
12	(1)	For the island of Hawaii, quadrangles H-1 to H-74;	
13	(2)	For the island of Kauai, quadrangles K-1 to K-11;	
14	(3)	For the island of Lanai, quadrangles L-North and	
15		L-South;	
16	(4)	For the island of Maui, quadrangles M-1 to M-17;	
17	(5)	For the island of Molokai, quadrangles M-East and	
18		M-West; and	
19	(6)	For the island of Oahu, quadrangles O-1 to O-15."	
20	SECT	ION 2. New statutory material is underscored.	
21	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
