3 **"PART IV. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS**

4 SECTION 7. The sum of [~~\$13,306,000~~] \$20,220,000
5 appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital
6 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
7 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
8 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
9 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; provided
10 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
11 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
12 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total
13 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of
14 dollars.

3 **"PART V. ISSUANCE OF BONDS**

4 SECTION 8. General obligation bonds may be issued, as
5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to
6 finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part IV of
7 this Act; provided that the sum of the general obligation bonds
8 so issued shall not exceed [~~\$8,086,000-~~] \$20,220,000."

9 SECTION 5. Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is
10 amended by adding two new sections to part VI as follows:

11 "SECTION 15.1. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding,

12 SECTION 6. If any portion of this Act or its application
13 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
14 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
15 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
16 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
17 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
18 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
19 extent possible.

20 SECTION 7. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
21 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
22 may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this
23 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular
24 session.
