A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"S6E- President Barack Obama historical markers. (a)
5	The department shall consult with the Hawaii tourism authority
6	and state foundation on culture and the arts to identify sites
7	in the State that were significant in the life of President
8	Barack Obama, the forty-fourth President of the United States of
9	America, and determine appropriate locations for historical
10	markers to indicate these significant sites.
11	(b) The department shall place historical markers at the
12	locations identified pursuant to subsection (a); provided that:
13	(1) If the location identified for a historical marker is
14	on privately owned property, the historical marker
15	shall only be placed if the property owner agrees to
16	have the marker placed at that location;

1	(2)	If an owner of private property does not agree to have	
2		a marker placed on the owner's property, the marker	
3		may be placed on public property in close proximity to	
4		that location; and	
5	(3)	If the location identified for a historical marker is	
6		a private residence, the historical marker shall be	
7		placed only if the owner agrees to have a historical	
8		marker placed either at the residence or on public	
9		property in close proximity to that location."	
10	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
11	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$20,000 or so much	
12	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the		
13	department of land and natural resources to place historical		
14	markers i	n the State to indicate sites that were significant in	
15	the life of President Barack Obama.		
16	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the state	
17	historic	preservation division of the department of land and	
18	natural r	resources for the purposes of this Act.	
19	SECT	TION 3. New statutory material is underscored.	
20	SPCT	TON 4 This Act shall take offect on July 1 2022
