A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the
3 sources of funding indicated below to collective bargaining
4 statewide (BUF 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2021-2023 all
6 collective bargaining cost items in the agreement negotiated
7 with the exclusive representative of collective bargaining
8 unit (1):

15 bargaining unit (1):

18 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this part
19 shall be allotted by the director of finance to the Hawaii

2 SECTION 11. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
3 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
4 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
5 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
6 from the respective funds.

7 SECTION 12. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations or
8 authorizations under this Act shall not lapse until the end of
9 fiscal biennium 2021-2023; provided that funds appropriated or
10 authorized by this Act that are not expended or encumbered by
11 June 30, 2023, shall lapse as of that date.

12 SECTION 13. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
