RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:****1** **PART I**

**2**       SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the

5 legislative officer or employee whose compensation is paid, in  
6 whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds shall be  
7 paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be, from the  
8 respective funds.

10       SECTION 16. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided  
11 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is  
12 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds  
13 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,  
14 from the respective funds.

15       SECTION 17. The fiscal year 2021-2022 appropriations or  
16 authorizations under this part shall not lapse until the end of  
17 fiscal biennium 2021-2023; provided that funds appropriated or  
18 authorized by this part that are not expended or encumbered by  
19 June 30, 2023, shall lapse as of that date.

20       SECTION 18. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


