## A BILL FOR AN ACT

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a lapse
- 2 date for any unencumbered moneys appropriated pursuant to Act
- 3 227, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021.
- 4 SECTION 2. Act 227, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is
- 5 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- 6 "SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the funds
- 7 received by the State of Hawaii from the American Rescue Plan
- 8 Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, (Section 9901), the sum of
- 9 \$1,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 10 year 2022-2023 for the purpose of providing, in whole or in
- 11 part, loans to nonprofit community development financial
- 12 institutions and nonprofit housing development organizations for
- 13 the development of affordable homeownership housing projects.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 15 housing finance and development corporation for the purposes of
- 16 this Act[-]; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2022, shall lapse as of that date."
