Dear Senate President Kouchi and Speaker Saiki:

The Hawai'i Government Employees Association (HGEA) and the employer have reached an agreement concerning collective bargaining (CB) for Unit 4 (White Collar Supervisors). Notification of ratification of the CB agreement was issued on April 22, 2022. In accordance with Section 89-10(b), cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation. A BILL FOR AN ACT

PART I

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
