Dear Senate President Kouchi, Speaker Saiki, and Members of the Legislature:

Pursuant to Section 73 of Act 88, SLH 2021, this is to notify you that I have approved the transfer of three positions between programs within the Department of Transportation (DOT) for operating purposes.

4. Responsibility of the positions prior to and after the transfer:

The responsibilities of the positions being transferred will be similar to their current responsibilities based on the proposed reorganization for the Oʻahu Airport District (AIR-O), which consolidates statewide functions from the Airports Operations Office, consolidates its human resources, and creates additional direct oversight of security operations at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport. The positions will be placed in a new section under AIR-O entitled Airport Security and Compliance.

6. Manner in which the transfer maximizes the utilization of personnel resources and staff productivity:

The transfer is needed to strengthen security programs at Hawai'i airports by consolidating staffing and supervision of a new section (Airport Security and Compliance) for AIR-O to meet the new requirements of the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), Code of Federal Regulations Title 49, and to comply with the terms of the TSA-DOT Settlement Agreement.
