BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$291-12 Inattention to driving. (a) Whoever operates
- 4 any vehicle negligently as to cause a collision with, or injury
- 5 or damage to, as the case may be, any person[τ] or vehicle [$\frac{or}{f}$],
- 6 pet animal, or other property shall be fined not more than \$500
- 7 or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both, and may be
- 8 subject to a surcharge of up to \$100, which shall be deposited
- 9 into the trauma system special fund.
- (b) For purposes of this section, "pet animal" means a dog
- 11 or cat and any domesticated rabbit, guinea pig, pig, horse, or
- 12 goat kept or raised by a household. "Pet animal" excludes feral
- 13 animals."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
