A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 205A-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending the definition of "development" to read as
3	follows:	
4	""De	velopment" means any of the uses, activities, or
5	operations on land or in or under water within a special	
6	managemen	t area that are included below:
7	(1)	Placement or erection of any solid material or any
8		gaseous, liquid, solid, or thermal waste;
9	(2)	Grading, removing, dredging, mining, or extraction of
10		any materials;
11	(3)	Change in the density or intensity of use of land,
12		including but not limited to the division or
13		subdivision of land;
14	(4)	Change in the intensity of use of water, ecology
15		related thereto, or of access thereto; and
16	(5)	Construction, reconstruction, or alteration of the
17		size of any structure.

1	"Dev	relopment" does not include the following:
2	(1)	Construction or reconstruction of a single-family
3		residence that is less than [seven thousand five
4		hundred] five thousand square feet of floor area, is
5		not situated on a shoreline parcel or a parcel that is
6		impacted by waves, storm surges, high tide, or
7		shoreline erosion, and is not part of a larger
8		development;
9	(2)	Repair or maintenance of roads and highways within
10		existing rights-of-way;
11	(3)	Routine maintenance dredging of existing streams,
12		channels, and drainage ways;
13	(4)	Repair and maintenance of underground utility lines,
14		including but not limited to water, sewer, power, and
15		telephone and minor appurtenant structures such as pac
16		mounted transformers and sewer pump stations;
17	(5)	Zoning variances, except for height, density, parking,
18		and shoreline setback;
19	(6)	Repair, maintenance, or interior alterations to
20		existing structures;

1	(7)	Demolition or removal of structures, except those
2		structures located on any historic site as designated
3		in national or state registers;
4	(8)	Use of any land for the purpose of cultivating,
5		planting, growing, and harvesting plants, crops,
6		trees, and other agricultural, horticultural, or
7		forestry products or animal husbandry, or aquaculture
8		or mariculture of plants or animals, or other
9		agricultural purposes;
10	(9)	Transfer of title to land;
11	(10)	Creation or termination of easements, covenants, or
12		other rights in structures or land;
13	(11)	Subdivision of land into lots greater than twenty
14		acres in size;
15	(12)	Subdivision of a parcel of land into four or fewer
16		parcels when no associated construction activities are
17		proposed; provided that any land that is so subdivided
18		shall not thereafter qualify for this exception with
19		respect to any subsequent subdivision of any of the
20		resulting parcels;

1	(13)	Installation of underground utility lines and
2		appurtenant aboveground fixtures less than four feet
3		in height along existing corridors;
4	(14)	Structural and nonstructural improvements to existing
5		single-family residences, where otherwise permissible;
6	(15)	Nonstructural improvements to existing commercial or
7		noncommercial structures; and
8	(16)	Construction, installation, maintenance, repair, and
9		replacement of emergency management warning or signal
10		devices and sirens;
11	provided	that whenever the authority finds that any excluded
12	use, acti	vity, or operation may have a cumulative impact, or a
13	significa	nt environmental or ecological effect on a special
14	managemen	t area, that use, activity, or operation shall be
15	defined a	s "development" for the purpose of this part."
16	SECT	ION 2. Section 205A-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended b	y adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
18	and to re	ad as follows:
19	" <u>"</u> Fl	oor area" means the roofed area of all floors of a
20	structure	measured from the exterior faces of the exterior walls
21	or from t	he center line of party walls dividing a structure; the

1	floor area	a of a structure, or portion of the floor area, that is
2	not enclos	sed by exterior walls shall be the area under the
3	covering,	roof, or floor that is supported by posts, columns,
4	partial wa	alls, or similar structural members that define the
5	wall line	. Excluded from the floor area are:
6	(1)	Parking structures, such as garages and carports,
7		including covered driveways and accessways, porte
8		cocheres, and parking attendant booths;
9	(2)	Attic areas with headroom less than seven feet;
10	<u>(3)</u>	Projections such as sunshade devices and architectural
11		embellishments that are decorative only;
12	(4)	Areas covered by roofing treatment to screen rooftop
13		<pre>machinery only;</pre>
14	<u>(5)</u>	Areas underneath unsupported roof overhangs or
15		cantilevered building overhangs; provided no portion
16		of the area is enclosed except for a safety railing or
17		wall not exceeding four feet in height;
18	<u>(6)</u>	Elevators and vent shafts;
19	(7)	Basements that are used exclusively for storage;

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1	(8)	Common walkways and other exterior common areas in
2		multi-family and commercial structures, such as
3		stairways, breezeways, and fire escapes; and
4	<u>(9)</u>	Exterior machinery and equipment enclosures, including
5		enclosures for laundry, water heaters, air
6		conditioners, and trash receptacles."
7	SECT	ION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
8	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
9	begun bef	ore its effective date.
10	SECT	ION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
