A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MANDATORY ETHICS TRAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that requiring all state 2 legislators and employees to be aware of and knowledgeable about
- 3 the state ethics code is in the best interests of the State.
- 4 Regular training on the state ethics code will ensure that state
- 5 legislators and employees are aware of current ethics laws and
- 6 will increase the public's confidence in state government.
- 7 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish live
- 8 and online ethics training courses to be designed and
- 9 administered by the state ethics commission and to make ethics
- 10 training mandatory for all state legislators and employees.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 84-42, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §84-42[+] Mandatory ethics training course. [All
- 14 state officers and employees enumerated in section 84-41] (a)
- 15 Legislators, members of the board of education, trustees of the
- 16 office of Hawaiian affairs, the governor, the lieutenant
- 17 governor, executive department heads and deputies, and every

1	other person whose illiancial discrosure statement is a public		
2	record pursuant to section 84-17(d) shall complete [an] a live		
3	ethics training course administered by the state ethics		
4	commission [as provided in this part. For the purposes of this		
5	part, "ethics training" includes education and training in:		
6	(1) The ethics laws set forth in this chapter; and		
7	(2) The lobbying laws set forth in chapter 97.] within		
8	ninety days of taking office and at least once every		
9	four years thereafter.		
10	(b) All other employees shall complete either a live or an		
11	online ethics training course administered by the state ethics		
12	commission within ninety days of becoming an employee and at		
13	least once every four years thereafter."		
14	SECTION 3. Section 84-43, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
15	amended to read as follows:		
16	"§84-43 Ethics training [courses; live and		
17	online. (a) The state ethics commission shall establish,		
18	design, supervise, and conduct live and online ethics training		
19	courses for [the officers to whom this part applies.] all		
20	persons required to complete training under section 84-42.		

1	(b)	The live ethics training course may be conducted in	
2	person or	via videoconference and shall include:	
3	(1)	Explanations and discussions of the ethics laws,	
4		administrative rules, and relevant internal policies;	
5	(2)	Specific technical and legal requirements;	
6	(3)	The underlying purposes and principles of ethics laws;	
7	(4)	Examples of practical application of the laws and	
8		principles; and	
9	(5)	A question-and-answer participatory segment regarding	
10		common problems and situations.	
11	The state	ethics commission shall develop the methods and	
12	prepare an	ny materials necessary to implement the <u>live ethics</u>	
13	training o	course.	
14	(c)	The online ethics training course shall include	
15	explanation	ons, discussions, and examples of the practical	
16	application of ethics laws and principles as the ethics		
17	commission	n deems appropriate. The state ethics commission shall	
18	develop th	ne methods and prepare any materials necessary to	
19	implement	the online ethics training course.	
20	[(c) -]	(d) The state ethics commission shall:	
21	(1)	Administer the ethics training [course;] courses;	

1	(2)	Designate those of its legal staff who are to conduct
2		the <u>live</u> ethics training course; [and]
3	(3)	Notify each [officer] legislator or employee
4		[enumerated in section 84-41], either directly or via
5		the employee's employing agency, that their attendance
6		or participation in [this] an applicable ethics
7		training course is mandatory[-]; provided that a
8		legislator's or employee's non-receipt of notice shall
9		not be a defense to a charge concerning a violation of
10		this chapter; and
11	(4)	Design and administer the online ethics training
12		course.
13	[(d)]	(e) The state ethics commission may repeat the <u>live</u>
14	course as	necessary to accommodate all persons who are required
15	to attend	
16	[(e)]	(f) Each state agency shall provide to the state
17	ethics co	mmission in a timely manner the names and electronic
18	mail addre	esses of those persons required to take the applicable
19	course [i	n a timely manner] and shall assist the commission by
20	providing	adequate meeting facilities and equipment for the
21	ethics tra	aining [course.] courses."

SECTION 4. Section 84-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 repealed. 3 ["§84-41 Applicability of part. This part applies to 4 legislators, members of the board of education, trustees of the office of Hawaiian affairs, the governor, the lieutenant 5 governor, and executive department heads and deputies. This 6 7 part does not apply to any other officer or employee of the 8 State."] SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, all 9 state legislators and employees who are in active service on the 10 11 effective date of this Act shall successfully complete a live or 12 online ethics training course, as applicable, within twelve 13 months following the effective date of this Act and at least once every four years thereafter; provided that the requirement 14 15 to successfully complete an ethics training course within the twelve month period immediately following the effective date of 16 this Act shall not apply to those state legislators or employees 17 18 who, within the past three years from the effective date of this Act, have successfully completed a live or online ethics 19 20 training course, as applicable.

- 1 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
