### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ensure that
- 2 everyone arriving in Hawaii is informed of how to safely and
- 3 responsibly enjoy their time on the islands by requiring the
- 4 Hawaii tourism authority to create educational videos,
- 5 educational audio recordings, and supplementary informative
- 6 paper material to be shown and distributed on incoming

- 8 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii tourism authority shall create
- 9 educational videos, educational audio recordings, and
- 10 supplementary informative paper material to be shown and
- 11 distributed on incoming commercial flights for everyone arriving
- 12 in the State. The educational videos, educational audio
- 13 recordings, and supplementary informative paper material shall
- 14 include information on:
- 15 (1) Preservation of natural resources;
- 16 (2) Ocean and outdoor safety;
