## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that proper management
- 2 and maintenance of watersheds are crucial to preventing loss of
- 3 life and protecting public and private property in nearby
- 4 communities. The legislature further finds that invasive
- 5 species such as albizia pose a serious threat to the State. For
- 6 instance, in Waiahole stream, the brittle nature of albizia has
- 7 led to heavy clogging of the stream, and the rapid growth of
- 8 albizia has crowded out native species. Furthermore, aquifers
- 9 cannot be replenished because the overgrowth of invasive species
- 10 prevents water from recharging aguifers.
- 11 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 12 division of forestry and wildlife of the department of land and
- 13 natural resources to establish a two-year pilot program to
- 14 remove invasive species such as albizia in and around Waiahole
- 15 stream on the island of Oahu.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) The division of forestry and wildlife of
- 17 the department of land and natural resources shall establish a

- 1 two-year pilot program to remove invasive species such as
- 2 albizia in and around Waiahole stream on the island of Oahu.
- 3 (b) The division of forestry and wildlife of the
- 4 department of land and natural resources shall submit a report
- 5 to the legislature regarding the pilot program no later than
- 6 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 7 2024.
- 8 (c) The pilot program shall cease to exist on June 30,
- 9 2024.
- 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for a
- 13 pilot program to remove invasive species in and around Waiahole
- 14 stream on the island of Oahu; provided that the moneys
- 15 appropriated by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the 2022-
- 16 2023 fiscal year; provided further that any moneys that remain
- 17 unencumbered on June 20, 2024, shall lapse on that date.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
