A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§706- Authority to impose probationary geographic
5	restriction; business districts; resort zones. A defendant who
6	has been convicted of a misdemeanor, has four prior misdemeanor
7	convictions, and each conviction was the result of an act that
8	occurred within a single business district or resort zoned area
9	may be sentenced to a probationary term of geographic
10	restriction not exceeding years during which the defendant
11	shall be prohibited from entering the district or area in which
12	the acts occurred. Violation of an imposed geographic
13	restriction shall be a misdemeanor. Conviction for the
14	misdemeanor of violation of an imposed geographic restriction

shall result in the person's imprisonment of thirty days.

1	An individual who lives or works within the district or
2	area in which the acts occurred shall not be prohibited from
3	entering the district.
4	For purposes of this section:
5	"Business district" means the territory contiguous to and
6	including a highway when within any six hundred feet along such
7	highway there are buildings in use for business or industrial
8	purposes, including but not limited to hotels, banks, or office
9	buildings, and public buildings which occupy at least three
10	hundred feet of frontage on one side or three hundred feet
11	collectively on both sides of the highway."
12	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14	begun before its effective date.
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Safe Neighborhoods; Probation; Geographic Restriction; Misdemeanor Conviction; Business Districts; Resort Zones Areas

Description:

Allows a defendant who has been convicted of four misdemeanors in any business district or resort zoned area to be sentenced to a probationary term of geographic restriction not exceeding an unspecified number of years during which the defendant shall be prohibited from entering the district or area in which the acts occurred. Mandates imprisonment of thirty days for violation.
