

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
  by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
  read as follows:

  "§26- Establishment of programs; reports. Any
  department or agency that establishes a funded program in
  accordance with an Act of the State shall submit a report on the
- 7 program to the legislature no later than one year following the
- 8 passage of the Act. The report to the legislature shall
- 9 include:
- 10 (1) All revenues, expenditures, and encumbrances for the program;
- 12 (2) The number of employees hired to staff the program;
- 13 (3) If the program was implemented within the year in
- which the enabling Act was passed; and
- 15 <u>(4)</u> Future plans for the program."
- 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
