

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's high								
2	school students and adult education students would benefit from								
3	a work readiness preparation program. A close collaboration								
4	between educators and industry employers would ensure that								
5	students develop the skills and credentials needed to make them								
6	highly employable.								
7	The legislature recognizes the benefit of allowing								
8	students, including students at adult and community schools, to								
9	earn associate degrees, workforce development diplomas, pre-								
10	apprenticeship certificates, and other industry-recognized								
11	certificates.								
12	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to establish and								
13	appropriate funds for:								
14	(1) An adult workforce readiness program;								
15	(2) One full-time equivalent adult workforce readiness								
16	program coordinator for McKinley community school for								
17	adults; and

1	(3) One full-time equivalent adult workforce readiness								
2	program coordinator for Waipahu community school for								
3	adults.								
4	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is								
5	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated								
6	and to read as follows:								
7	"§302A- Adult workforce readiness program; established								
8	(a) There is established within the department an adult								
9	workforce readiness program to be administered by the adult and								
10	community education program.								
11	(b) The department shall designate schools, including								
12	adult and community schools, that may participate in the								
13	program.								
14	(c) Designated adult workforce readiness program schools								
15	shall provide opportunities for students to earn associate								
16	degrees, as well as workforce development diplomas, pre-								
17	apprenticeship certificates, and other industry-recognized								
18	certificates that assess and document the student's readiness								
19	for a wide range of employment.								
20	(d) The department may coordinate with the department of								
21	labor and industrial relations and the department of human

- 6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 9 the development and implementation of the adult workforce
- 10 readiness program and to establish and hire two full-time
- 11 equivalent (2.0 FTE) adult workforce readiness program
- 12 coordinators to be placed at McKinley community school for
- 13 adults and Waipahu community school for adults.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

Report Title:

Department of Education; Adult Workforce Readiness Program; Establishment; Appropriation

Description:

Establishes within the department of education a workforce readiness program to provide opportunities for students to earn associate degrees, workforce development diplomas, preapprenticeship certificates, and other industry-recognized certificates. Requires the department to designate schools, including adult community schools, to participate in the program. Appropriates funds for the workforce readiness program and two full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) adult workforce readiness program coordinator positions.
