### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CANNABIS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the purpose of the
- 2 medical cannabis dispensary system law is to ensure that
- 3 qualified patients have safe, timely, and adequate access to
- 4 medical cannabis. The legislature further finds that the
- 5 coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has severely
- 6 impacted the way in which qualifying patients can safely access
- 7 the facilities that provide medical cannabis. Many qualifying
- 8 patients suffer from debilitating conditions that make them
- 9 especially vulnerable to exposure, and seek alternative ways to
- 10 physically access facilities and minimize exposure.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of
- 12 health to approve under certain conditions in-vehicle receipt of
- 13 medical cannabis and manufactured cannabis products on or near
- 14 the premises of dispensaries.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 329D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending subsection (n) to read as follows:

1	"(n)	A dispensary shall [be prohibited from] not make an
2	off-premi	ses delivery of cannabis or manufactured cannabis
3	products	to a qualifying patient, primary caregiver, qualifying
4	out-of-st	ate patient, or caregiver of a qualifying out-of-state
5	patient[.	], unless authorized by the department and:
6	(1)	The dispensary receives a pickup order by telephone or
7		electronic means from the qualifying patient, primary
8		caregiver, qualifying out-of-state patient, or
9		caregiver of the qualifying out-of-state patient;
10	(2)	The qualifying patient, primary caregiver, qualifying
11		out-of-state patient, or caregiver of the qualifying
12		out-of-state patient arrives in a vehicle, provides
13		the license number for the vehicle, and notifies the
14		dispensary upon arrival at the dispensary in a
15		designated area for pickup;
16	<u>(3)</u>	The area designated for pickup:
17		(A) Is no further than one hundred feet from the main
18		entry of a secured retail location;
19		(B) Complies with section 329D-6(f) and 329D-7(6);
20		(C) Is monitored by a video recording system that:
21		(i) Is under the control of the dispensary; and

1			(ii) Regularly records and stores video of pickup
2			transactions, including vehicles, vehicle
3			license plates, and persons receiving the
4			medical cannabis or manufactured cannabis
5			product;
6	(4)	Befo	re providing the medical cannabis or manufactured
7		cann	abis product, the dispensary confirms the identity
8		of t	he qualifying patient, primary caregiver,
9		qual	ifying out-of-state patient, or caregiver of the
10		qual	ifying out-of-state patient by:
11		<u>(A)</u>	Verifying that the license plate number of the
12			vehicle matches the number stated by the
13			qualifying patient, primary caregiver, qualifying
14			out-of-state patient, or caregiver of the
15			qualifying out-of-state patient at the time the
16			order was placed;
17		<u>(B)</u>	Reviewing valid photographic identification in
18			the form of a state identification card, driver's
19			license, or passport;
20		<u>(C)</u>	Requiring the person attempting to receive the
21			order to sign an acknowledgment of receipt; and

1	<u>(D)</u>	Comparing the signature provided pursuant to
2		subparagraph (C) with the signature on the
3		photographic identification described in
4		subparagraph (B) or another reliable signature
5		sample; and
6	<u>(5)</u> The	amount of medical cannabis or manufactured
7	cann	abis products received do not exceed the
8	<u>limi</u>	tations established by the department."
9	SECTION 3	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
10	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
11	begun before i	ts effective date.
12	SECTION 4	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5	. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
