

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TRANSFER OF NON-AGRICULTURAL PARK LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 90, Session Laws
- 2 of Hawaii 2003 (Act 90), was enacted to transfer certain non-
- 3 agricultural park lands from the department of land and natural
- 4 resources to the department of agriculture. While three hundred
- 5 parcels consisting of approximately nineteen thousand acres have
- 6 been transferred over the past seventeen years, many parcels
- 7 have not been transferred.
- 8 The legislature further finds that Act 139, Session Laws of
- 9 Hawaii 2021, established the Act 90 working group to determine
- 10 the process, status, challenges, and potential remedies
- 11 regarding the transfer of non-agricultural park lands to fulfill
- 12 the purposes of Act 90. The working group determined that
- 13 certain lands would be considered eligible for transfer if an
- 14 easement were provided to allow the department of land and
- 15 natural resources or the public to access an adjacent parcel.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to adopt a recommendation from
- 17 the Act 90 working group that authorizes the department of

- 1 agriculture to inquire with the department of land and natural
- 2 resources, prior to offering a lease, regarding any easements
- 3 required on the lands that are subject to the lease.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 166E-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 "\$166E-3 Transfer and management of non-agricultural park
- 7 lands and related facilities to the department of agriculture.
- 8 (a) Upon mutual agreement and approval of the board and the
- **9** board of land and natural resources:
- 10 (1) The department may accept the transfer of and manage
- 11 certain qualifying non-agricultural park lands; and
- 12 (2) Certain assets, including position counts, related to
- the management of existing encumbered and unencumbered
- 14 non-agricultural park lands and related facilities
- shall be transferred to the department.
- 16 (b) The department shall administer a program to manage
- 17 the transferred non-agricultural park lands under rules adopted
- 18 by the board pursuant to chapter 91. The program and its rules
- 19 shall be separate and distinct from the agricultural park
- 20 program and its rules. Non-agricultural park lands are not the
- 21 same as, and shall not be selected or managed as are lands under

1	agricultural	park leases.	Notwithstanding	any	other	law	to	the
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- 2 contrary, the program shall include the following conditions
- 3 pertaining to encumbered non-agricultural park lands:
- 4 (1) The lessee or permittee shall perform in full compliance with the existing lease or permit;
- (2) The lessee or permittee shall not be in arrears in the
 payment of taxes, rents, or other obligations owed to
- 8 the State or any county;
- **9** (3) The lessee's or permittee's agricultural operation
- shall be economically viable as specified by the
- 11 board; and
- 12 (4) No encumbered or unencumbered non-agricultural park
- lands with soils classified by the land study bureau's
- productivity rating class A or B shall be transferred
- for the use or development of golf courses, golf
- driving ranges, and country clubs.
- 18 The transfer of non-agricultural park lands shall be done in a
- 19 manner to be determined by the board of agriculture.
- 20 (c) For any encumbered or unencumbered non-agricultural
- 21 park lands transferred to the department that are not being

- 1 utilized or required for the public purpose stated, the order
- 2 setting aside the lands shall be withdrawn and the lands shall
- 3 be returned to the department of land and natural resources.
- 4 (d) Before any transfer of certain qualifying non-
- 5 agricultural park lands, the department may request from the
- 6 department of land and natural resources any information related
- 7 to the establishment of easements by necessity upon the lands."
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
