

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is								
2	amended by adding a new section to part I be appropriately								
3	designated and to read as follows:								
4	"§321- Testing laboratory; diseases; water quality.								
5	(a) The department shall:								
6	(1) Establish and operate a laboratory capable of:								
7	(A) Testing for diseases and air and water quality								
8	issues; and								
9	(B) Other high complexity testing; and								
10	(2) Ensure that the testing laboratory complies with all								
11	applicable standards enumerated in the Clinical								
12	Laboratories Improvement Amendments of 1988 (42 U.S.C.								
13	263 et seq.).								
14	(b) The department may obtain and expend federal moneys								
15	for the operation of the testing laboratory established pursuant								
16	to this section."								

1	SECTION	2.	There	is	appropriated	out	of	the	general

- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the
- 4 department of health to establish and operate a testing
- 5 laboratory pursuant to this Act.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
