A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the display permit
- 2 fee, which authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to conduct
- 3 outdoor and close proximity fireworks for public or private
- 4 events or for theatrical or movie purposes, has remained the
- 5 same for fifteen years. However, the costs of processing,
- 6 reviewing, and approving display permits have increased. The
- 7 consumer and cultural permit fees have also remained the same
- 8 for years.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to ensure the effective
- 10 administration of the fireworks display permitting process by
- 11 increasing the consumer and cultural permit fees and the
- 12 fireworks permit fee.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 "\$132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the
