

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1.	The	director	οf	finance	is	authorized	t.o	issue

- 2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$22,720,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023
- 5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
- 6 second representative district, as follows:
