A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BROTHER JOSEPH DUTTON DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Ira Barnes Dutton
- 2 was born on April 27, 1843, in Stowe, Vermont, and spent his
- 3 formative years in Janesville, Wisconsin. After the Civil War
- 4 broke out, Ira Barnes Dutton enlisted in the Union Army in
- 5 September of 1861 as part of Company B of the thirteenth
- 6 Wisconsin infantry and was discharged in 1866 due to a
- 7 downsizing of the military after the war. Following the war,
- 8 Ira Barnes Dutton suffered from post-traumatic stress disorder
- 9 and other personal problems, leading him on a journey to seek
- 10 atonement through the Catholic faith and taking on the name of
- 11 his favorite Saint, Joseph, when he was baptized.
- 12 The legislature further finds that upon learning about the
- 13 work of Father Damien on Molokai, Joseph Dutton made his way to
- 14 Hawaii, arriving at Kalaupapa in July of 1886 to assist Father
- 15 Damien, who had been diagnosed with leprosy. Joseph Dutton soon
- 16 became an expert in caring for patients while working alongside
- 17 Father Damien, who affectionately called him "Brother". After

- 1 Father Damien's death three years later in 1889, Joseph Dutton
- 2 managed the Baldwin Home for Boys for leprosy victims and
- 3 dedicated the remainder of his life to the residents of
- 4 Kalaupapa until he became ill and was transferred to St. Francis
- 5 Hospital in Honolulu, where he passed away on March 26, 1931.
- **6** The purpose of this Act is to establish April 27 of each
- 7 year as Brother Joseph Dutton Day to honor the hard work and
- 8 dedication of Brother Joseph Dutton in helping residents of
- 9 Kalaupapa.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 11 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 12 read as follows:
- "§8- Brother Joseph Dutton Day. April 27 of each year
- 14 shall be known and designated as "Brother Joseph Dutton Day";
- 15 provided that this day is not and shall not be construed to be a
- 16 state holiday."
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2044.
