BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The legislative reference bureau shall
- 2 conduct a study to consider if the Hawaii supreme court should
- 3 be a single term like the United States Supreme Court.
- 4 (b) The legislative reference bureau shall submit a report
- 5 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 6 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 7 to the convening of the regular session of 2023.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
