A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-117, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Any candidate may withdraw in writing for any reason
- 4 not later than 4:30 p.m. on the second business day immediately
- 5 following the close of filing [for any reason] and may withdraw
- 6 after the close of filing up to 4:30 p.m. on the fiftieth day
- 7 prior to an election for reasons of ill health. When a
- 8 candidate withdraws for ill health, the candidate shall give
- 9 notice in writing to the chief election officer if the candidate
- 10 was seeking a congressional or state office, or the candidate
- 11 shall give notice in writing to the county clerk if the
- 12 candidate was seeking a county office. The notice shall be
- 13 accompanied by a statement from a licensed physician or
- 14 physician assistant indicating that such ill health may endanger
- 15 the candidate's life.
- 16 A candidate who withdraws the candidate's own nomination
- 17 papers prior to the close of filing shall not be considered to

- 1 have caused a vacancy that may be filled by a party under
- 2 section 11-118."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
