A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD WELFARE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that having modern 2 software that child welfare caseworkers can access on their 3 mobile phones during case visits and doing field work will allow 4 workers to more effectively manage their caseloads to meet the 5 growing number of children in foster care, ensure that Hawaii 6 can meet the national standard for monthly visits, improve case 7 planning, and strengthen child and family involvement to improve 8 mental and behavioral health outcomes for youth and the health 9 needs for children.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 11 (1) Require the child welfare services branch of the
 12 department of human services to establish a pilot
 13 program to develop a modern case management software
 14 solution compatible with existing child welfare
 15 technology; and
- 16 (2) Appropriate funds for this purpose.

9	to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the			
10	convening of the regular sessions of 2023 and 2024, including a			
11	status update on the development of the child welfare services			
12	case management software solution, findings and recommendations			
13	and any proposed legislation.			
14	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general			
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
