# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STUDENT TRANSPORTATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of education provides regular bus service for qualified public 2 3 school students to facilitate compliance with the State's 4 compulsory attendance law and transportation of school children 5 law, as well as with federal law relating to the provision of a 6 free and appropriate education. According to the department of 7 education, the daily student ridership average for regular 8 education students is 35,090 students per day and 3,359 per day 9 for special education students. The legislature further finds 10 that the school bus service provided by the department of
- education is essential for getting students to and from school,
  particularly for students who lack other transportation options
  or face hardship in obtaining school transportation services due
  to economic difficulty.
- The legislature also finds that to qualify for regular

  school bus service, students in grades K-5 must reside a mile or

  more, and students in grades 6-12 must reside 1.5 miles or more,

- 1 from the school within their attendance area. Students who
- 2 qualify for school bus service may receive a free bus pass if
- 3 they meet eligibility requirements; or pay \$36.00 for quarterly
- 4 one-way trips, \$72.00 for quarterly round trips, or \$10.00 for
- 5 ten coupons. The legislature finds that a student who qualifies
- 6 for free lunch under the free and reduced price lunch program is
- 7 eligible for a free bus pass; however, free bus passes do not
- 8 extend to students who qualify for reduced lunch under the free
- 9 and reduced price lunch program. Students and families of
- 10 households who qualify for the reduced lunch price would also
- 11 benefit from receiving free bus passes.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 13 education to create a tiered student bus fare rate system for
- 14 the department of education's school bus program.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 302A-406, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$302A-406 Transportation of school children. (a) The
- 18 department may provide suitable transportation to and from
- 19 school and for educational field trips for all children in
- 20 grades kindergarten to twelve and in special education classes.

17	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
18	revenues of	the State of Hawaii the sum of \$	or so
19	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to		
20	carry out the purposes of this Act.		

1	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
2	education for the purposes of this Act.		
3	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
5	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050;		
6	provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

### Report Title:
